PROJECT BRIEF

The Thompson's are a young couple who recently bought a mixed use property to live and work from. The first floor would be used as a commercial space for their small batch textiles company and the second floor would serve as their residence.

CHALLENGES

The main challenge presented in this project is to create a live work space that is fully functional and aesthetically pleasing. Also, to organize the space in a way that creates a separation between the private residence and the public commercial space. The floor plan has a limited amount of windows and access to natural light.


SOLUTIONS

The solution to the challenge of creating a mixed use project was to separate the private and public areas by utilizing the lower floor for the commercial entity and using the second floor for the private residence. Designing spaces that feel curated and unique to the client helps to create a space that feels like a retreat rather than just an extension of the workplace.










Powder Bath










Casita



CHALLENGES


The main challenge in this project was mainly designing a space that felt updated by did not interfere with the architectural style and integrity of the house.



ADU Renovation



PROJECT BRIEF

This ADU renovation is a part of an entire home renovation project I worked on for a house in Rancho Santa Fe, CA. I was asked to design a space that could function as an office, ADU, and guest room.

CHALLENGES

The Main challenges presented of course was the space, all of the client's specific needs of the space had to be met while still having comfortable living space. The most challenging request was a king bed.

SOLUTIONS

I approached the space by boxing out the important elements that needed to fit into the space. I then decided to use a cal king murphy bed to gain better clearances around the bed when is pulled down without sacrificing soft seating in the room.

I was asked to redesign an ADU to accommodate a working space, king murphy bed and kitchenette. The client asked for a more modern sleek design so I used wood tones for warmth and stone to achieve a sleek finish. Lighting and linear lines played a major role in this design.






Kitchenette






To save space I used a cal king murphy bed to allow for a comfortable sleeping area for guest but also allowing the space to be used as an office or lounge when it is not occupied by guest.
